



Solar Power System Warranty:

1. It is a condition precedent to the Company's liability, and it is warranted that the solar power system installed on the insured premises must comply with the following requirements:
 - 1.1. the solar power system must be installed by an accredited electrical contractor as recognised by the Department of Labour;
 - 1.2. installation must be accompanied by and comply with:
 - 1.2.1. a valid Electrical Certificate of Compliance (CoC);
 - 1.2.2. the latest edition of SANS 10142-1 (Wiring);
 - 1.2.3. NRS 097-2-1 (utility interface/inverter);
 - 1.2.4. any other regulatory requirements (where applicable);
 - 1.2.5. relevant municipal by-laws;
 - 1.3. the solar power system must be regularly maintained and kept in good working order;
 - 1.4. the Insured's staff must be educated and trained in the operation of such solar power system installed on the insured premises;
 - 1.5. all bushes, grass, weeds and other flammables within a 5m (five metre) radius of the solar power system must be cleared and regularly maintained.
2. It is further noted and agreed that any consequential loss of any nature whatsoever arising from damage to the solar power system is hereby excluded.
